





Europeana at the start - problem space

- Cultural heritage data was under-represented on the web
- Cultural heritage institutions worked in isolation in a very fragmented landscape
- Principles supported by the sector such as free access to culture for everyone was under threat (e.g. Google Books)
















What is a data space?

"distributed system defined by a governance framework that enables secure and trustworthy data transactions between participants while supporting trust and data sovereignty"


(as defined by the Data Space Support Centre)

⇒ An emphasis on sovereignty and decentralisation, where data owners - as opposed to platforms - keep control of data.







With a history of 15 years, we have a head start to build on over all the other data spaces but we are not there.







Deployment of the data space

The data space builds on the Europeana Initiative's accomplishments - from open data and community building to data aggregation.




Europeana ecosystem




